PLAYING OTHER SPORTS MAKES YOUA BETTER HOCKEY PLAYER

Despite warmer weather and closing of arenas, the concept of hockey becoming a full year sport has come to fruition. For the past 9 months, families have dedicated countless hours, school-days, weeknights, and weekends to hockey. When does the hockey season truly end?

Although we cannot determine an exact end date for all winter hockey seasons, athletes are encouraged to participate in other sports and activities during the spring and summer seasons - utilizing these seasons as necessary phases for mental and physical rejuvenation. Are there downfalls associated with year-round sport specialization?

Thinking about hockey 24/7 and 365 days a year, is not mentally stimulating, facilitates mental burnout, decreases drive, and ultimately increases the possibility of being injured or dropping out of the sport. Playing hockey 24/7 and 365 days a year also overuses the 'hockey muscles', facilitates physical burnout, and also increases the possibility of being injured. Be sure to give the mind and body proper rest and recovery opportunities, while also incorporating other sports and activities into an athlete's routine. According to Wayne Gretzky, "If a sport has a high point of the year, it must be the first week of spring. When I was growing up, I used to love this time of year. It was when I put my hockey equipment away and I was absolutely ecstatic to see the end of the hockey season." Bobby Orr agrees, "Kids don't need to play all year, they can have a program of light exercise and play other sports. If you look at the best players in all sports, they're athletes— they play other sports." Although the main reasons for participating in other sports and activities should be for fun and maintenance of physical health; on-ice hockey skills can actually be improved through other off-ice sports and activities. What are the benefits of participating in sports and activities, other than hockey, throughout the spring and summer?

Participating in other sports and activities helps to develop a more well-rounded athlete, increases physical literacy and movement skills, and allows the brain and body to rest and activate in different environments.

To quote Corey McNabb, Director, Hockey Development Programs at Hockey Canada, "The ability to learn agility, balance, and coordination that comes from playing a variety of sports, builds a solid foundation for athletic success, physical fitness and more importantly, staying active for life." Are there sports and activities during the spring and summer, which will provide increased benefits to an athlete during the hockey season?

According to John Tavares of the New York Islanders, "People always talk about my hand-eye coordination and how that translates from lacrosse to hockey and from hockey to lacrosse, which is true," said Tavares, who played lacrosse for 13 years before switching focus solely to hockey. "But the biggest thing that translated for me was using my body to protect the ball, spinning off checks and moving through traffic. All of those things translated into skills on the ice that have helped me excel in many areas in hockey, such as puck protection, moving through traffic and gaining time and space from tight checking." There are several spring and summer sports and activities which have transferable skills to hockey. Here are a few examples of the connections between other sports and hockey, and the benefits to developing versatile, athletic hockey players:

BASKETBALL

Being able to dribble the ball while moving and keeping your head up at the same time is one of the key technical skills of basketball. Basketball offers lessons in spacing – you need to work to get open for a shot, creating passing and shooting lanes. It offers a very similar up-and-down the court action to hockey, and all five players are responsible on both offence and defence (playing man or zone defence). Another similarity is in how basketball defenders in the post "box out" attacking players after the offensive scoring opportunity. In hockey, this is a valuable transferable skill to learn when establishing body position in front of the net as a defender or a forward to either clear out or score on a rebound.







Ball protection is another transferable skill from basketball. The way basketball players use their footwork, legs, and hips to protect the ball is precisely what hockey players are taught when they learn how to protect the puck from defenders. On the other side of the ball, the way basketball players use effective footwork and controlled body contact to defend by containing attacking players is similar to how hockey players battle in the corners and along the wall for puck possession.



When devising strategies for a power play, hockey players can learn effective ways to attack by watching how basketball teams run their offensive strategies. For example, basketball's "Triangle Offense" is quite similar in its purpose to hockey's "Box and One" power play. The "bump-man (middle man)" in hockey works to create coverage confusion, forming multiple triangles with the corners of the box and creating out-manned situations.





TENNIS

Tennis offers lessons in power and speed bursts. Being able to hit the ball in the location where you want it to go is great for accuracy practice and moving to and from the net in quick succession is great for learning how to appropriately use your speed. Putting some spin on the ball as well as hitting backhand or forehand teaches different shot techniques, much like in hockey. The sport also allows players to participate individually or with a partner, changing the mental aspect of the game.

As for goaltenders, tennis offers lessons in stance, hand-eye coordination, and lateral movement. Most racquet sports are terrific compliments to how a goalie moves, stands, and thinks during the game of hockey.





SOCCER



Much like basketball, soccer offers a fast-paced, quick-thinking style of play. The sport is great for working on footwork and has a similar action to one-timers on fast passes.

Cycling the ball back to the defence for a reset also mimics what can happen on the ice. Transition has become an increasingly important concept in the game of hockey. Team's which use their defense to exit areas of pressure and move the puck from defence to offense quickly are often very successful. Just because the soccer ball isn't moving forward doesn't mean the offence isn't working.





BASEBALL

Quick reaction times and critical thinking skills are just some of the benefits that baseball offers. Making smart decisions on the base paths and being able to judge the strike zone helps to build the mental side of an athlete. Being aware of how many outs there are is another aspect of the game that can affect what decisions are made. And of course, hitting the ball at the plate requires a great deal of hand-eye coordination. The swing style for baseball and shot pathway for hockey are very similar.





While this article only focuses on a few of the many similarities between these sports and hockey, there are several other sports and activities that share transferable skills with hockey. It is interesting to observe that when broken down, other sports bare similar respective links to hockey.

Based on these observations, it can be argued that sport variety and versatility prevents burnout and developmental plateau, while also developing transferable skills for hockey. By sampling multiple sports and striving to become the best athlete that one can be; the chances of becoming an elite level athlete are actually increased. "At the youngest ages, we shouldn't try to develop hockey players. We should develop athletes who love hockey" (USA Hockey's American Development Model (ADM) Regional Manager, Bob Mancini).


Policy Making Hockey Safer

There is a hot debate concerning policy disallowing body checking in some age groups and levels of play in youth hockey. Some parents believe that it is a necessary part of the game, while others are concerned about injury and concussion risk which will be reduced substantially through policy disallowing body checking. Researchers at the Sport Injury Prevention Research Centre (SIPRC) at the University of Calgary have conducted multiple studies evaluating the link between body checking policy and injury and concussion risk in youth ice hockey in Pee Wee (ages 11-12), Bantam (ages 13-14) and Midget (ages 15-17). Paul Eliason, a PhD student at the SIPRC, shares some of the findings lead by his co-supervisor and Chair of the SIPRC, Dr. Carolyn Emery.

Ice hockey is one of Canada's most popular winter sports for youth, with over a half million players registered with Hockey Canada in the 2015-16 season. However, ice hockey has a high risk of injury, including concussion. As part of the research conducted by the SIPRC in ice hockey, we have recruited Pee Wee, Bantam, and Midget players from Alberta, British Columbia, Ontario, and Quebec starting in 2007 through to the current season.

Here is what our research has found to date:

- **1.** Body checking is the single most consistent risk factor for injury and concussion in youth ice hockey.
- **2.** Following the 2013 national body checking policy change that eliminated body checking in all levels of Pee Wee (ages 11-12), there was a 50% reduction in injury risk and a 64% reduction in concussion risk.
- **3.** The body checking policy change evaluation results translate to an estimated 581 concussions prevented annually in Alberta and over 4800 concussions prevented annually in Canadian Pee Wee players.

- **4.** Preliminary results evaluating body checking policy disallowing body checking in Bantam (ages 13-14) non-elite levels of play demonstrates a 64% reduction in injury risk and 57% reduction in concussion risk.
- **5.** In a comparison of the injury rates between Bantam players from Alberta (who had body checking experience in Pee Wee) and Quebec (did not have body checking experience in Pee Wee), there were no significant differences in the rate of concussion or overall injury. As such, having body checking experience in Pee Wee does not decrease the risk of sustaining a concussion or injury for Bantam players.
- **6.** Based on video analysis, disallowing body checking in Pee Wee led to an 87% reduction in high intensity player to player contacts. Additionally, there were no negative implications for in-game offensive performance (e.g., puck possession, completed passes, shots on goal). In fact, there was greater successful completion of offensive passes in leagues where body checking was not allowed.
- **7.** Based on video analysis, disallowing body checking in non-elite Bantam lead to a 91% reduction in high intensity player to player contacts.

Research at the SIPRC continues to evaluate how body checking policy changes impact several outcomes including:

- 1. The risk of players sustaining a concussion and or other injury
- 2. In-game performance (e.g., puck possession, completed passes, shots on goal)
- 3. The nature and severity of player-to-player contacts
- 4. Long term recovery and time to return-to-sport and return-to-learn
- 5. Health care utilization through economic evaluation



Concussion

- Is one of the most common injuries in youth ice hockey
- Is a traumatic brain injury induced by biomechanical forces
- Can present in a variety of signs and symptoms including headache, sensitivity to light and noise, problems with concentration and memory, balance problems, slowed reaction times, problems with sleep, and irritability
- The signs and symptoms can be present in a delayed fashion (i.e., several hours or even days) and can change over time



- Any player suspected of sustaining a concussion should be immediately removed from play and not return-to-play until evaluated and cleared to return-to-play by a physician
- Most children with a concussion will recover normally with their symptoms resolving over time, though 15% may have persistent symptoms
- Any player diagnosed with a concussion should follow the care of their physician before returning to play

Take Away

The research conducted at the Sport Injury Prevention Research Centre has shown that adopting policies which disallow body checking from certain levels of youth hockey has substantially reduced the number of injuries, including concussions in youth ice hockey. Further, allowing body checking in Pee Wee is not protective of injury or concussion in Bantam. Finally, disallowing body checking does not negatively impact offensive performance. These results are important to Hockey Edmonton as an organization because these injuries and concussions can lead to children not playing the game we all love. While disallowing body checking from specific levels of the game will not completely eliminate injury risk, it has decreased the risk of injury and concussion substantially in our young players. This allows the players more time to develop all skills with a reduced risk that they may be out for part of the season or stop participating in the longer term. A focus on playing the game for fun and skill development is critical for the long-term development and continued participation of all youth players.
